

Nova Scotia Association of Garden Clubs Minutes of the Annual General Meeting Via Email and Phone June 5, 2021

The following is an excerpt from an email that was distributed to the clubs via the District Directors:

For the second year, we are unable to get together for the NSAGC convention and the annual general meeting (AGM). Last year (2020) we skipped the AGM and the existing Board agreed to remain in place for one more year to provide continuity until we could vote on a new one.

There are a number of clubs that have not met due to not being familiar with the required technology. To ask them to join a Zoom AGM would provide challenges and possibly exclude them from the process. Therefore, this year we have decided to hold the AGM voting via email.

As with any AGM, we need each club to vote on the minutes from the 2019 meeting, the nominations for the Board of Directors and the (unaudited) Financial Statements. Both the Board list and the Financial Statements must be submitted to the Registry of Joint Stock Companies early in June so that NSAGC's registration remains in good standing. In order to pass these items we need a quorum of clubs, which means that it is important to get your vote.

The following are a few notes about the Board of Directors:

- 1. Tags & Seals has become the responsibility of the Treasurer and is no longer a Board Position.
- 2. Web Master has been removed as a position on the Board for the current time. We are in the process of reviewing our social media approach (web site, Facebook, etc.) and therefore we are rethinking this position. Stay tuned for a new, modern web site later in the year!
- 3. The District 3 North Director position is open. It is important that all districts have a Director on the Board so please nominate someone to represent your interests.

Please note that the Financial statements are not audited at this point. The Treasurer and two Board members have not been able to meet to review the transactions due to COVID. As was the case last year, Joint Stocks will be made aware of this situation.
